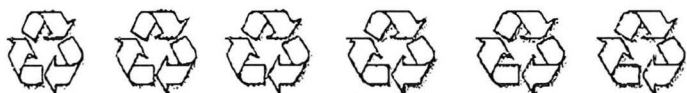

PLEASE THOROUGHLY RINSE AND IF POSSIBLE, FLATTEN.

PLASTICS NOT ACCEPTED:

Plastic bags, sheets, film or tarps
Motor Oil, Insecticide or Herbicide Containers
Styrofoam Blocks
Styrofoam Peanuts
Expanded foam and clear polystyrene (#6 plastic)

Please rinse and if possible, flatten Aluminum foil & pie plates

Cookie Tins or other decorative tins
Food and empty aerosol cans
Please rinse, and if possible, flatten
Please remove labels
No paint cans



MIXED PAPER

Examples are:

Magazines/Telephone Book/Catalogs
Junk Mail/ Envelopes
Brown Paper Grocery Bags
Typing, Computer Printout Paper, Note Paper
Frozen food trays and boxes
Chip board, i.e. Cereal boxes (with liner removed)
Gift boxes, Small boxes (unwaxed), paper tubes
Corrugated Boxes
***Please remove packing peanuts and all plastic materials from shipping boxes.*
Wet strength carrier stock
Office Paper/ School Paper, Annual Reports
MLS Books, NCR Forms
FOR OFFICE USE: Please remove plastic covers and steel binders.

GLASS BOTTLES AND JARS:

Clear, brown, green and blue
Please rinse
You DO NOT need to remove labels

No window glass, ceramics, mirrors, light bulbs, Pyrex or dishes.



Note: With "Single Stream Recycling", all recyclable items can be commingled in the same recycling cart.

Recycling Collection Schedule

Recycling collection occurs the first and third Wednesday of the month.

If a collection day falls on or after a holiday: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas Day, collection for that week will shift to the next day – excluding Sundays. Please refer to the calendar below to check for any changes in your collection day throughout the year.
